## <u>ORDER</u>

Defendant Fireman's Fund Insurance Company has filed a notice of removal of a civil action from state court and asserts that federal jurisdiction exists under 28 U.S.C. § 1332(a) because the parties are diverse and the amount in controversy exceeds \$75,000. The plaintiff, Signicast, LLC, is a limited liability company, and the citizenship of a limited liability company is the citizenship of each of its members. <u>See, e.g., Wise v.</u> <u>Wachovia Sec., LLC</u>, 450 F.3d 265, 267 (7th Cir. 2006). However, the notice of removal does not identify the citizenship of Signicast's members, and so I cannot satisfy my independent duty to ensure that federal jurisdiction exists.

**THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED** that defendant identify the citizenship of each of Signicast's members within ten days of the date of this order.
