ORDER

On December 2, 2021, the court held a telephonic hearing to discuss how this case will proceed. respond to each of the defendant's proposed findings of fact. (*See* ECF No. 172.) Defendant may file a reply no later than January 24, 2022.

If the court denies the motion, it will consider plaintiff's September 29, 2021 motion to compel. (ECF No. 169.)
