ORDER

On August 20, 2021, the Court screened Plaintiff's complaint, determined that Plaintiff failed to state a claim for relief, and provided Plaintiff until September 20, 2021 to amend his complaint. Accordingly, the Court will dismiss this case without prejudice for failure to state a claim and issue a strike pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g).

Accordingly,


IT IS ORDERED that this action be and the same is hereby **DISMISSED without prejudice** for failure to state a claim; and
