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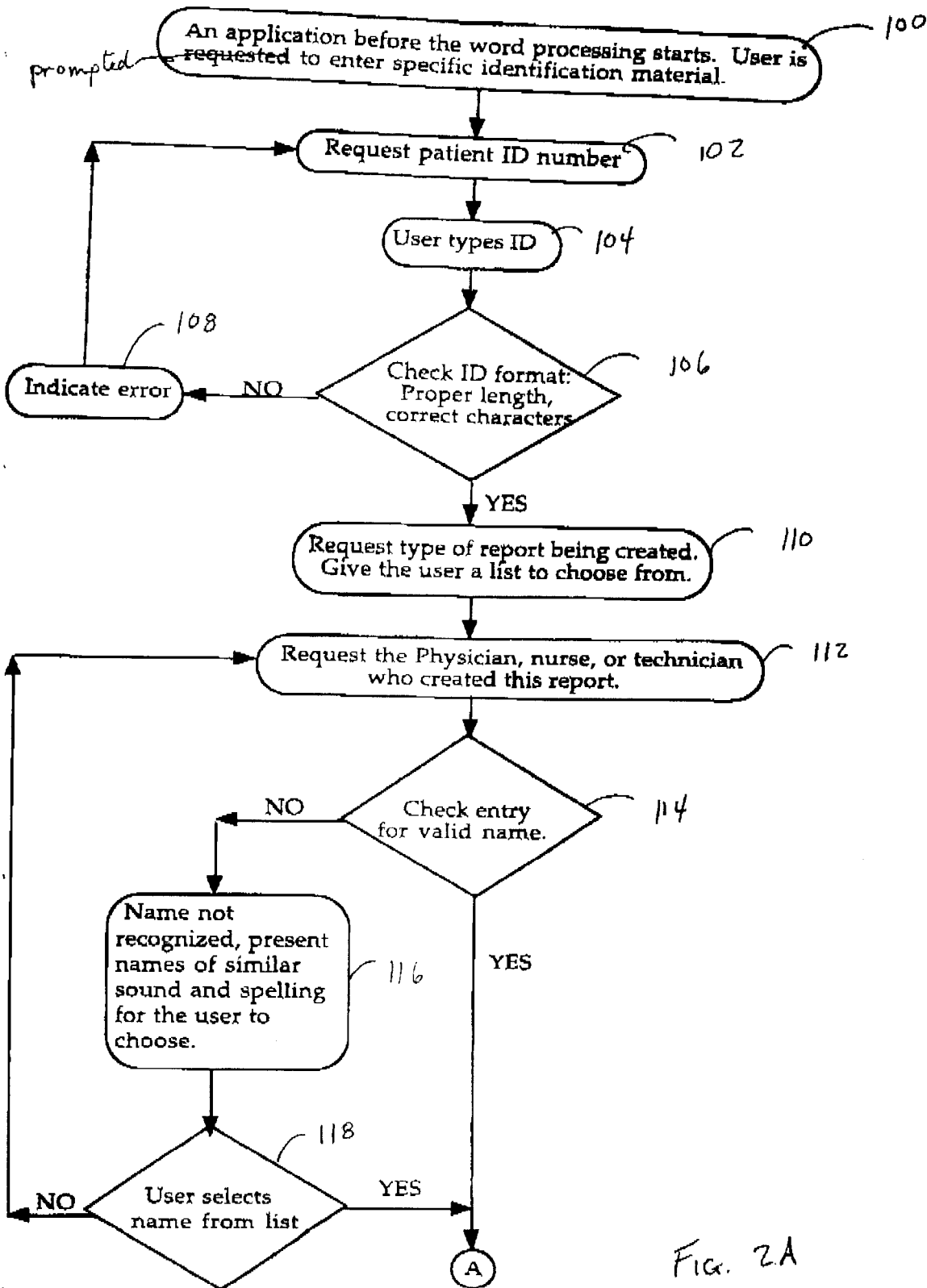
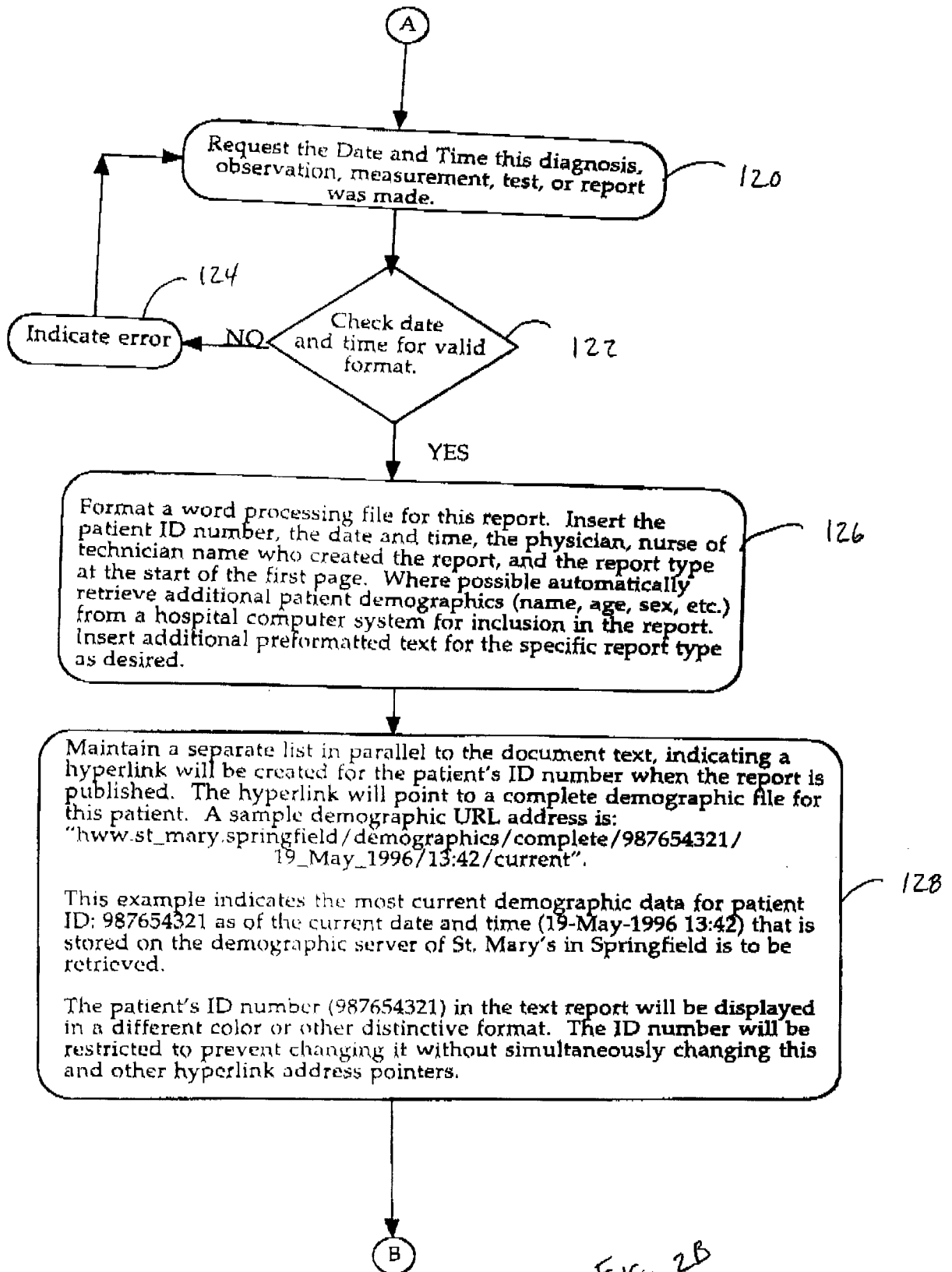

The separate list will indicate a hyperlink will be created for the author when the report is published. The hyperlink will point to a complete contact file for this person. A sample address is: "hww.st_mary.springfield/staff_directory/S_E_Markelson".

The authors name will be displayed in a different color or other distinctive format. The name will be restricted to prevent changing it without simultaneously changing the hyperlink address pointers. Similar restriction will be enforced regarding the date and time and the report type. They cannot be changed without the new information being reflected in the creation of various file pointers for this report.

The separate list will indicate the file name or address that is to be used to reference this report when it is published. This address can be used by any other report or document to link to this report. The linkage may easily be done via a hyperlink specifying this address. If the report that is being entered to the word processor is a discharge report for patient ID: 9987654321 and the current date and time is 19-May-1996 13:42, then the address that will be used to reference this report will be:

"hww.st_mary.springfield/discharge/987654321/19_May_1996/13:42".

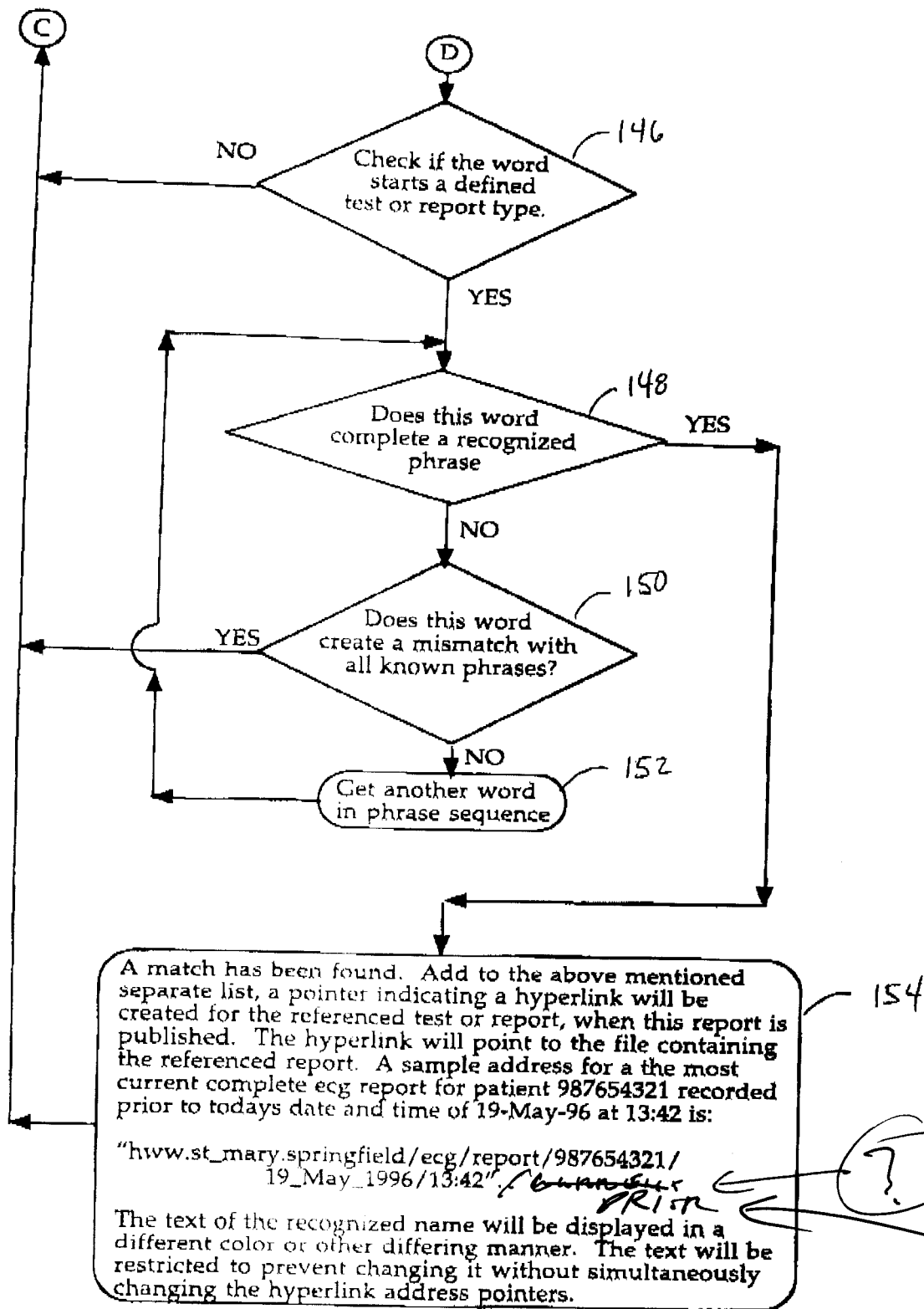

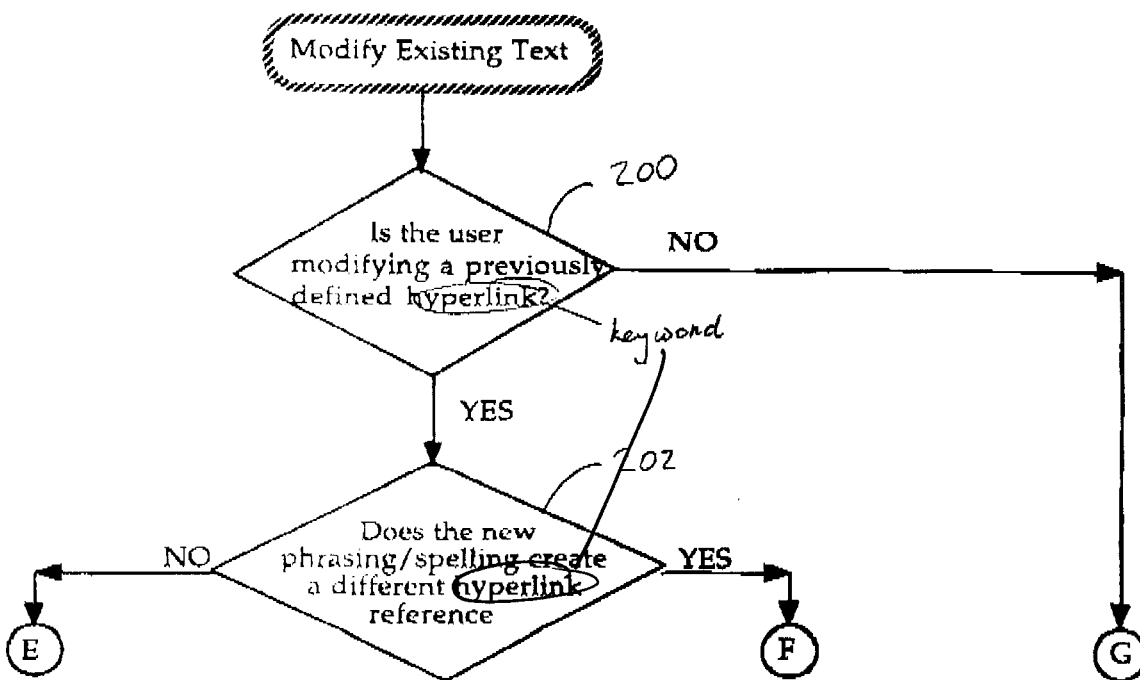

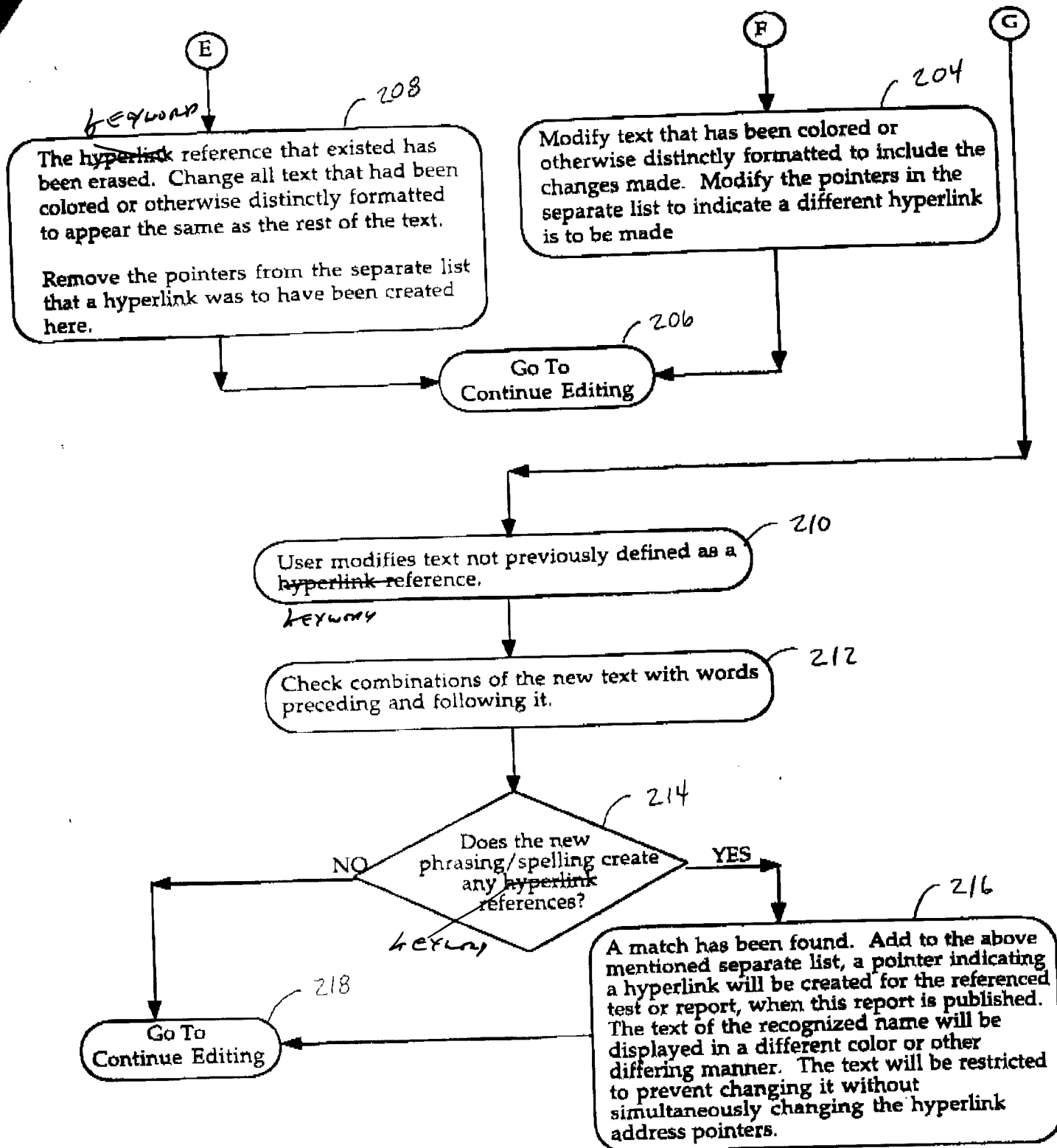

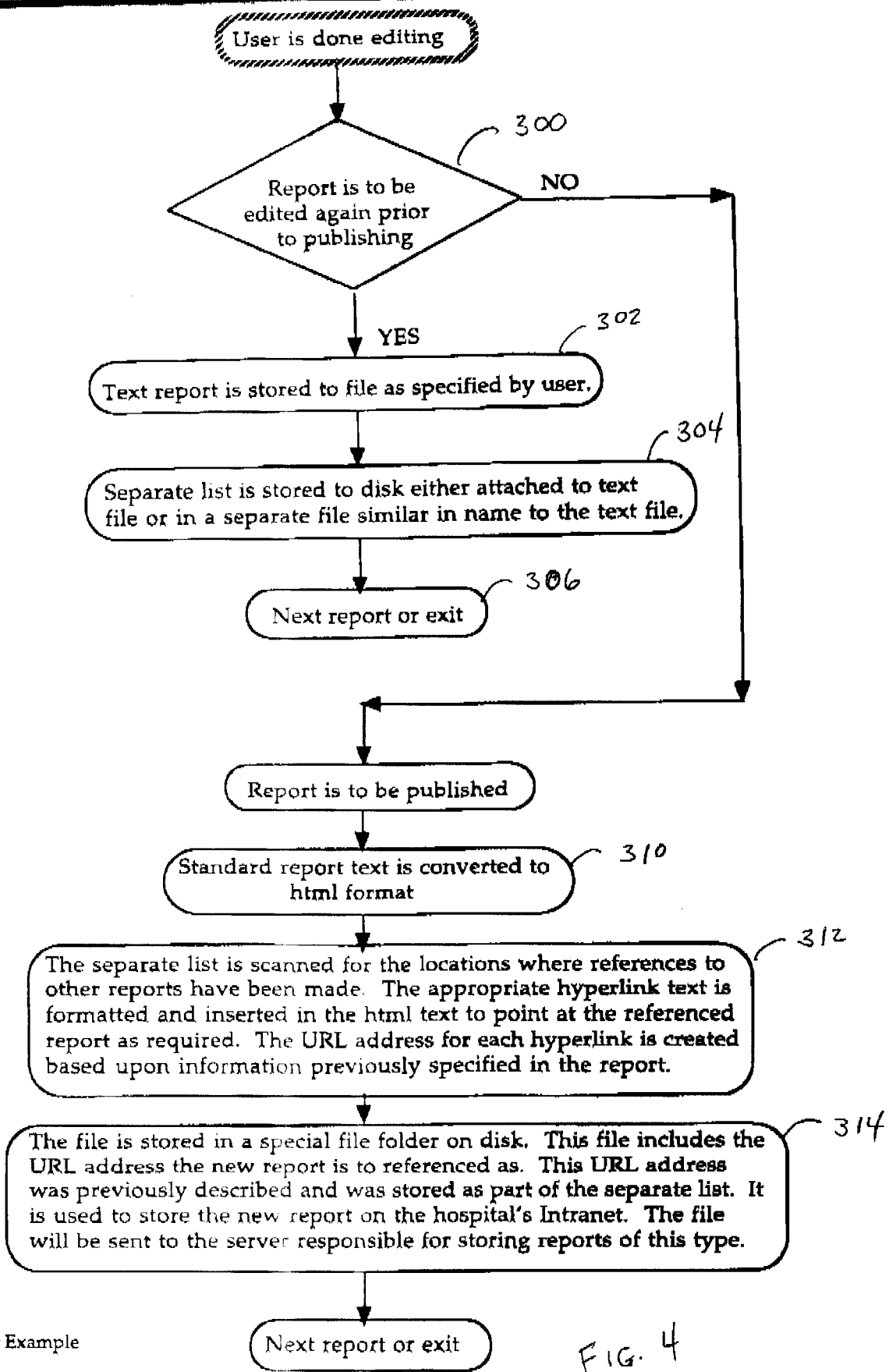

Example using a special leading character

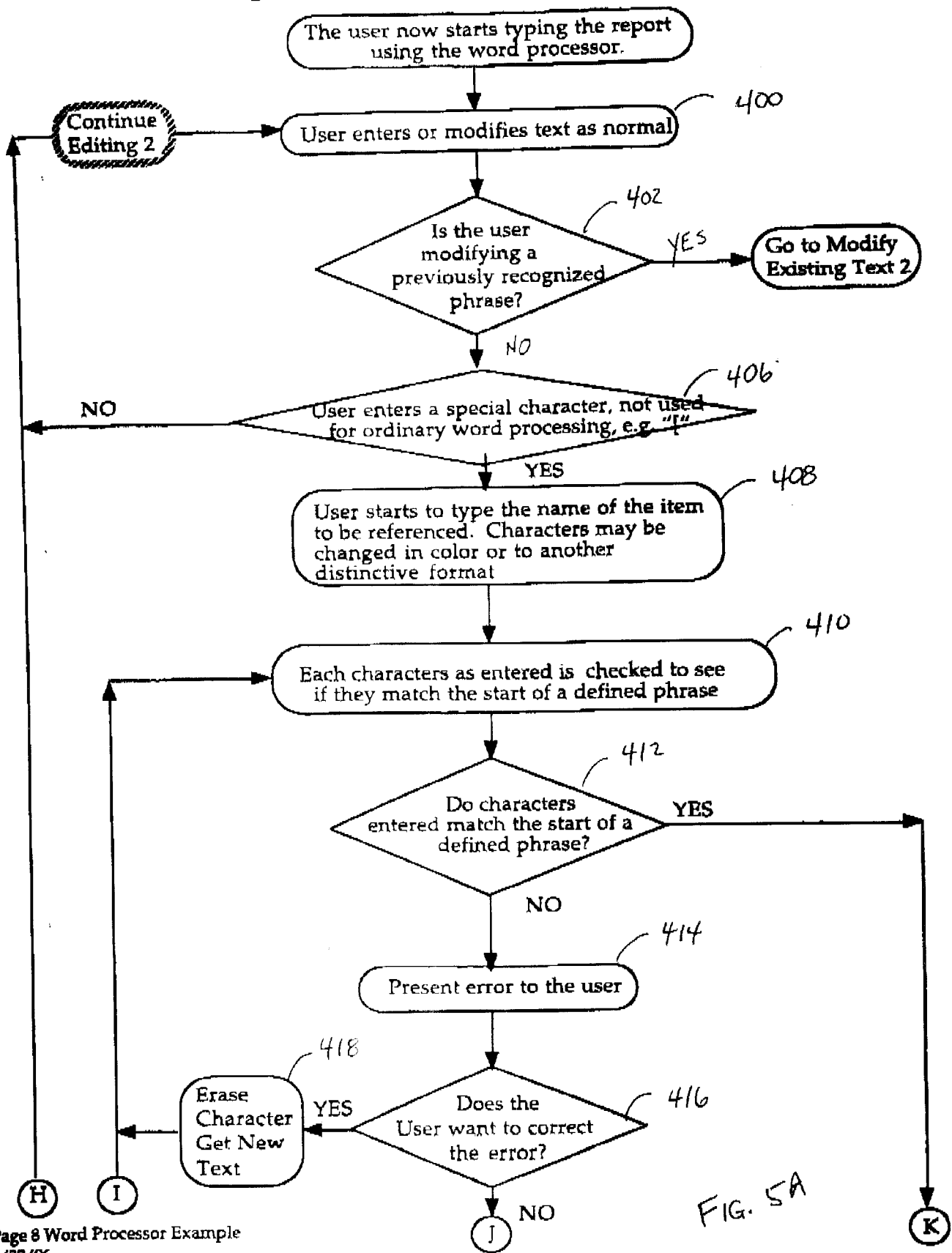
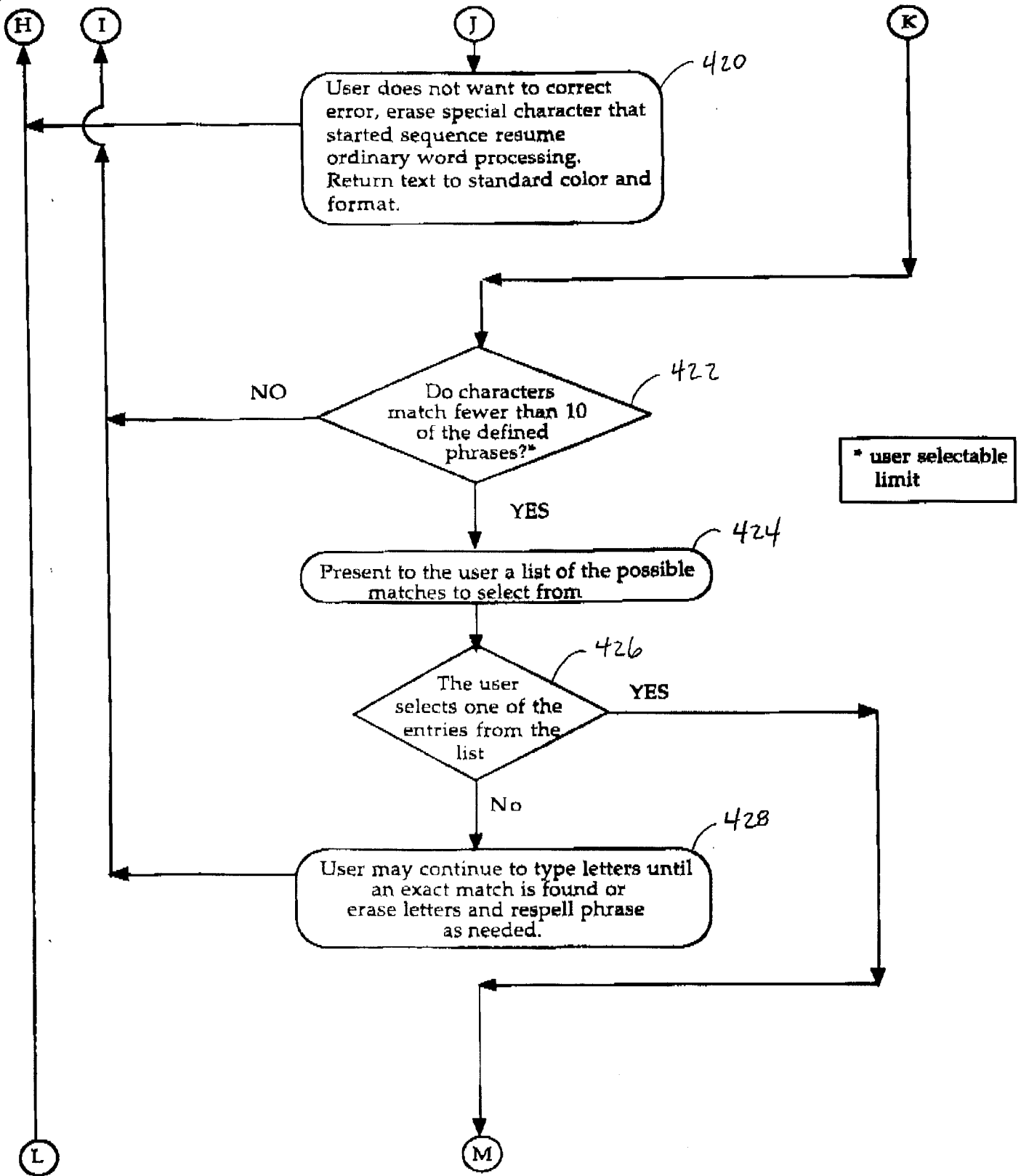

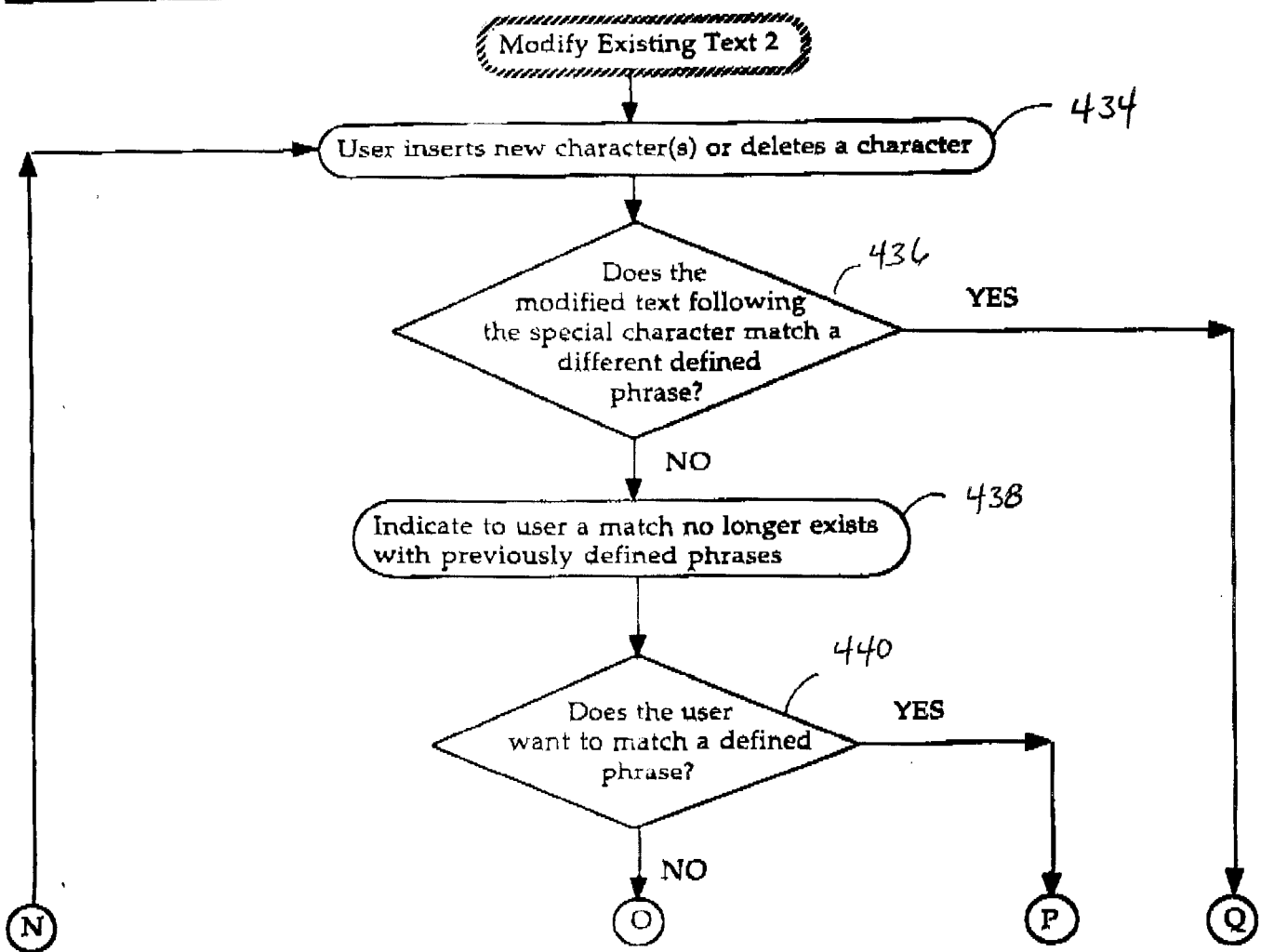
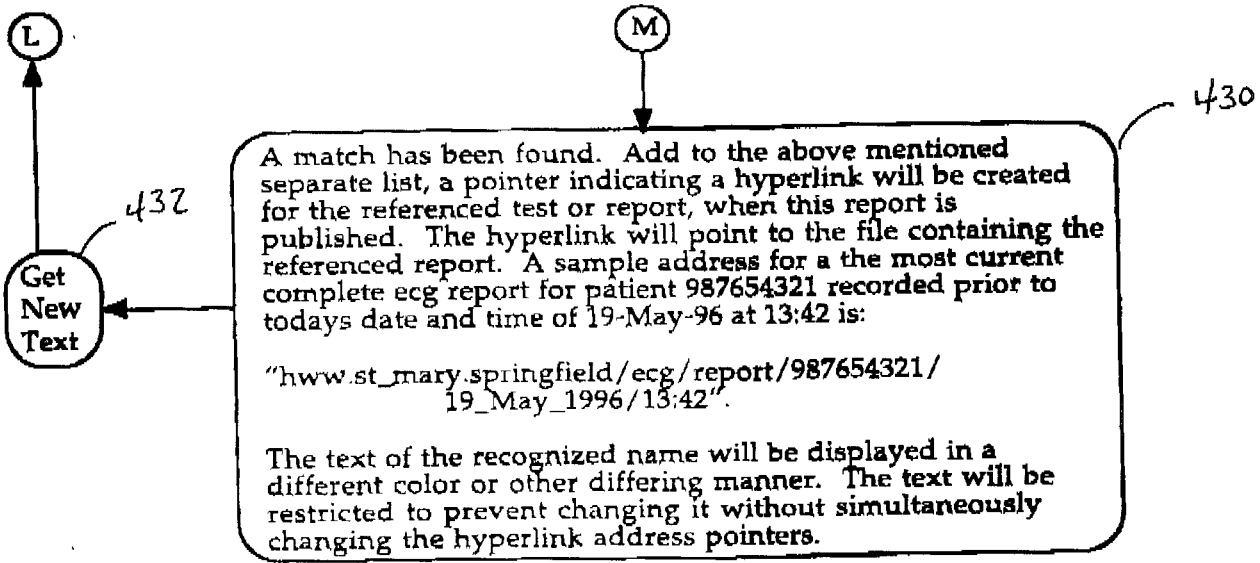

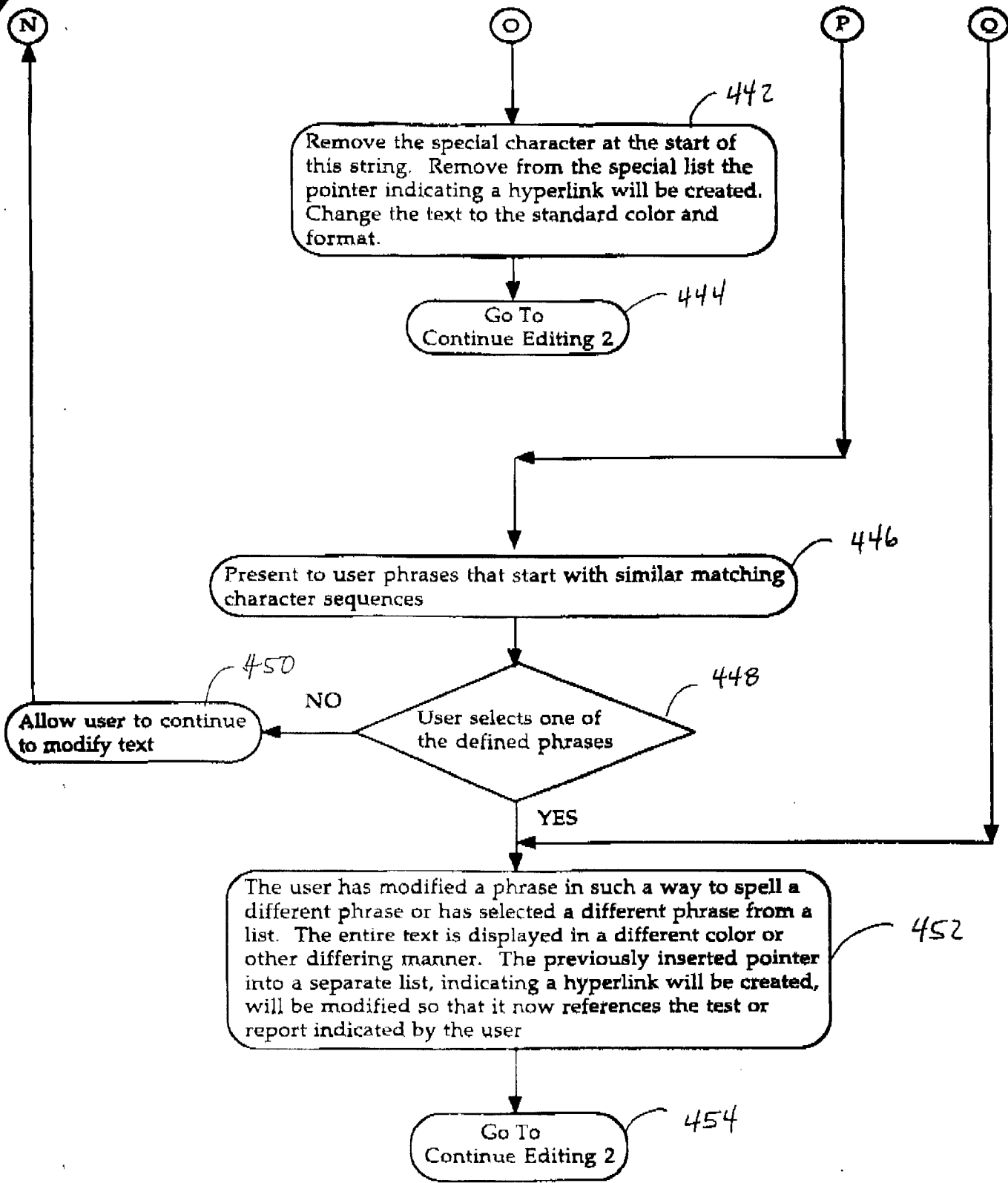

Example of a general purpose brochure customized for each patient using an hospital Intranet and standardized URL addressing

Preliminary Formatting:

The text of standard printed brochure relating to patient care is converted to html format. 500

Each diagram, picture, or graphic is converted to a jpeg, gif, or other format compatible with being displayed by a software browser. 502

Graphics that are unique to the brochure are given a unique network URL address. They will be retrieved when the brochure is displayed from a hospital Intranet. A sample URL would be:
"hww.st_mary.springfield/brochures/heart_occlusion/clogged_artery.jpeg"
for a drawing of a clogged artery in a brochure relating to coronary artery occlusions stored on a server or file folder called "brochures". 504

Graphics that can be replaced with the similar graphics from each patient's file will be given a special URL. An example would be:
"hww.st_mary.springfield/brochures/heart_occlusion/cath_diagram/XXXXXXXXXX/date/time/current"
The text XXXXXXXXXX is to be replaced by the patient's ID number. The date and time would be replaced by the current date and time whenever this brochure is viewed.
Note that normally patient data files containing a cath diagram are normally stored on a server or in a file folder called "cath". In this case a request will be made for it on the server or file folder combination of the name "brochures/heart_occlusion" 506

Viewing Brochure with a **Browser:**

An Intranet **browser** is started. A location known to be the address of a series of files that compose a library of information for patients is entered.

508

The user is requested to enter identification information regarding themselves. This will either include their patient ID number or other information that will allow their patient ID can be found.

510

The user is presented with a list of brochures that have been converted to Intranet format.

512

In this case the user selects the brochure listed as "Heart Occlusions"

514

The user clicks on the text of the brochure name engaging a hyperlink to retrieve the brochure selected. The file containing the brochure is retrieved.

516

Graphics that are unique to the brochure are also retrieved and inserted with the text.

518

Graphics that have been formatted with the text "XXXXXXXXXX/date/time/current" will be retrieved specially. The Intranet server responsible for providing the brochure (e.g. "brochures") being retrieved will attempt to reformat the URL for this requested graphics to be compatible with the standardized URL addressing used by the hospital Intranet.

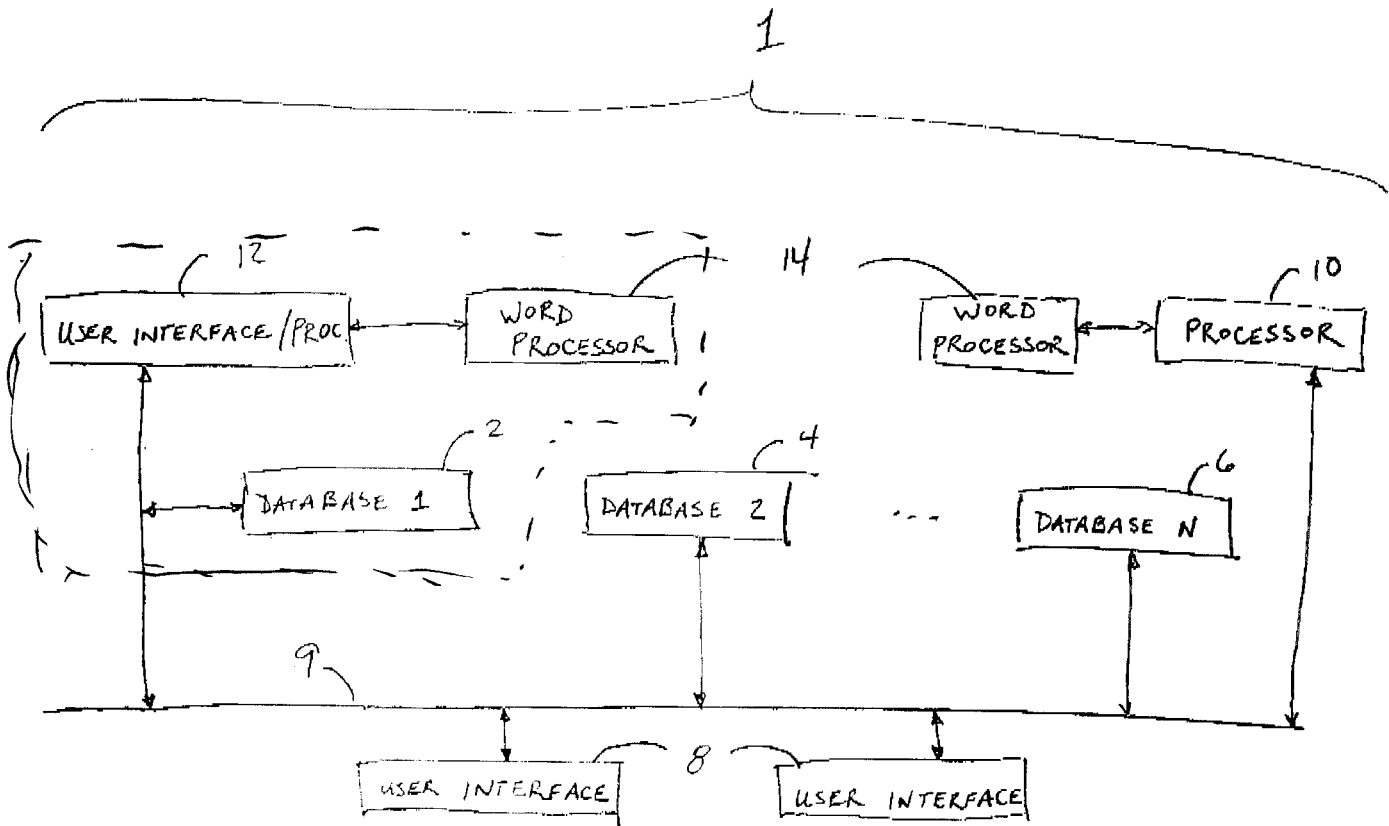
