- (2) a motion for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*, the affidavit required by 28 U.S.C. § 1915, and a certificate from the warden or other appropriate officer of the place of confinement showing the amount of money or securities that the petitioner has in any account in the institution.

As of the date of this order petitioner has not submitted either the filing fee or the paperwork necessary to support a determination that petitioner is entitled to proceed without paying the filing fee.

A copy of a blank application for leave to proceed in forma pauperis is being

mailed to petitioner with this order. Petitioner should complete it and return it to

the court on or before January 22, 2008. Alternatively, petitioner must submit

the \$5 filing fee. The court will take no further action on the petition until

petitioner returns a completed application for leave to proceed in forma pauperis or

submits the filing fee. If petitioner fails to make either of these submissions on or

before January 22, 2008, the court will dismiss the petition for failure to

prosecute.
