Dear Mr Rosenbrock,


I am in receipt of your facsimile letter to Mr. Tony Sarll of 23 January.

In response to your request, Motorola has not yet finally determined whether or not its IPR are in fact essential to the W-CDMA proposal, and does not know what will be the final contents of the proposal in the event of adoption.

Motorola will, however, agree to grant licenses under its IPR essential to a W-CDMA standard, if and when adopted by ETSI, on fair, reasonable, and non-discriminatory terms in accordance with Clause 6.1 of the ETSI IPR Policy, provided that those who seek licenses agree to reciprocate.
