State inmate David A. Schlemm filed this civil action against prison officials pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983, alleging violations of the Religious Land Use and Institutionalized Persons Act, 42 U.S.C. § 2000cc-1, and the Free Exercise Clause found in the First Amendment. The defendants have filed a motion for summary judgment and the court has granted Schlemm an extension of time to respond.
