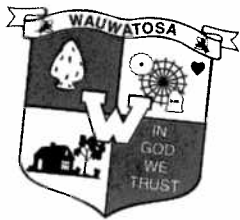

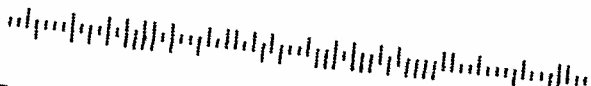


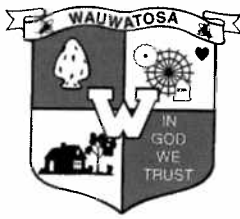

Dear Ms. Fertel-Rust:

I was directed by the Wauwatosa Police and Fire Commission to investigate the complaint you filed with them regarding your interaction with our police department. I reviewed the police report from April 11, 2011.

On that date, our officers responded to a complaint from a citizen who stated they felt you were intending to harm yourself by jumping in front of traffic. The officers engaged you in front of Whitman Middle School and determined that it did not appear that you were intending to injure yourself. They offered you assistance which you declined.

The officers handled this incident in an appropriate and professional manner. While you might not concur, they dutifully responded to a call and attempted to assist you. This is exactly what police officers are trained to do. It is the expectation of this community and this agency.
