The next exhibit in Special Collections will explore the history, artifacts, and myths of Anglo-Saxon England and their many political and cultural uses. Featuring printed books from the 16th century through the present, the exhibit is designed to complement the biennial conference of the International Society of Anglo-Saxonists, to be held in Madison in summer 2011. Books on display will highlight reflections of (and on) Anglo-Saxon England, including renderings of language of the period, depictions of archaeological finds, chronicles of Christianization, and accounts—whether sober or fanciful—of custom, dress, and battle.
