The parties appeared for a hearing in this case on September 12, 2012. Plaintiff participated by telephone from Milan, Italy; his counsel Rhonda Hazen was present in the courtroom; defendant was present in person, with her counsel Kenneth Sipsma. Because Mr. Sipsma had been hired only recently and had not had an opportunity to prepare for the hearing, the parties agreed that the hearing would be continued until September 18, 2012.
