It was found that the Plaintiff Due Process was violated for the 1,350.00 restitution with no evidence to show. ON 29th Day of July, 2015 Plaintiff was granted leave to proceed on his fourteenth amendment Due Process claim against Defendants Michael Meisner, David Melby, Donald Morgan and Mary Leiser for not having evidence to support the
