In an order entered on January 4, 2017, I gave relator Gina Truly until January 25, 2017 to inform the court whether she wished to pursue this case, and if she did, to have an attorney appear on her behalf, noting that Truly cannot prosecute *qui tam* claims as a pro se litigant. Dkt. 11. In addition, I warned Truly that if she failed to respond to the January 4 order, this case would be dismissed without prejudice *Id.* at 2. It is now past Truly's deadline, and she has not responded to the court's order. Accordingly, I will dismiss the case.

IT IS ORDERED that this case is DISMISSED without prejudice. The clerk of court is directed to enter judgment and close this case.
