01/28/2016	2	** TEXT ONLY ORDER ** Defendant Shawn Winrich has filed a Notice of Removal, seeking to remove a case in which he is a criminal defendant from Marquette County Circuit Court. <i>State of Wisconsin v. Winrich</i> , Case No. 2015CM000096. As the federal removal statute permits removal only in civil actions, 28 U.S.C. § 1441(a), and this is a criminal prosecution, this matter must be remanded back to state court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1447. Dismissal is also appropriate under the abstention doctrine set forth in <i>Younger v. Harris</i> , 401 U.S. 37 (1971), which requires dismissal of a matter when "federal jurisdiction would intrude into ongoing state criminal proceedings." <i>Mulholland v. Marion Cty. Election Bd.</i> , 746 F.3d 811, 815 (7th Cir. 2014). Accordingly, this matter is REMANDED back to the Marquette County Circuit Court, and this case is DISMISSED. Signed by District Judge William M.
