ORDER

Petitioner James Robert Turner seeks a writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. Petitioner has submitted a motion for leave to proceed without prepayment of the filing fee. (Dkt. # 2). The court cannot consider this motion, however, because it lacks supporting documentation regarding petitioner's eligibility for indigent status. For this case to move forward, petitioner must either pay the \$5 filing fee or submit a certified inmate trust fund account statement (or institutional equivalent) for the six-month period immediately preceding the filing of this habeas corpus petition. If petitioner does not submit either the \$5 filing fee or a trust fund account statement before July 6, 2017, the court will assume that petitioner wishes to withdraw this action voluntarily and will dismiss the petition.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. No later than July 6, 2017, petitioner James Robert Turner shall pay the \$5 filing fee or submit a certified copy of petitioner's inmate trust fund account statement for the six-month period from the date of the habeas petition (December 13, 2016 through at least June 13, 2017).

2. If petitioner fails to pay the \$5 filing fee, comply as directed, or show cause for failure to do so, the court will assume the petitioner wishes to withdraw this petition.
