PER CURIAM.

The final order is affirmed with the exception of those rulings pertaining to claimant's colon and stomach conditions, which we reverse pursuant to <u>Claims</u>

Management, Inc. v. Grenier, 777 So. 2d 1039 (Fla. 1st DCA 2000). We remand to permit claimant to proceed with an independent medical examination (IME) by a physician who specializes in those conditions.
