PER CURIAM.

The petition is granted and Matthew James Daily is hereby afforded a belated appeal from the order of the Circuit Court for Okaloosa County, which denied in part

and granted in part postconviction relief after an evidentiary hearing in case numbers 01-1755 and 02-2033. Because Daily was resentenced, the appeal shall be treated as a plenary appeal from judgment and sentence. <u>King v. State</u>, 795 So. 2d 1086 (Fla. 1st DCA 2001).
