PER CURIAM.

The trial court filed its order denying Mr. Sosnowski's postconviction motion on April 28, 2020. Mr. Sosnowski had 30 days from that date to file a notice of appeal, but he presumptively filed his notice of appeal on June 1, 2020, when he gave his notice to prison officials. *See Fla. R. App. P. 9.420(a)(2)(A)* (providing for presumption that an inmate has filed a document "on the date the inmate places it in the hands of" a corrections official). After reviewing Mr. Sosnowski's response to our show cause order, we DISMISS this appeal as untimely.
