PER CURIAM.

The former wife appeals the trial court's findings that temporary alimony and child support were excessive and its award of a credit for the overpayment. In approving this overpayment credit, we follow our decision on this same issue in *Flores v. Flores*, 874 So. 2d 1211 (Fla. 4th DCA), *review granted*, (June 29, 2004). *See also Dent v. Dent*, 851 So. 2d 819 (Fla. 2d DCA 2003) (Stringer, J., concurring specially). We find the former wife's other arguments to be without merit.
