PER CURIAM.

William Grant Sanders appeals the summary denial of his Motion for Court Transcripts at State Expense. We affirm. See *Vanover v. State*, 946 So. 2d 1152, 1152 (Fla. 4th DCA 2006) (“Beyond the record provided for a direct appeal, [a prisoner] is not entitled to free transcripts to assist in the preparation of either a postconviction motion or a petition for extraordinary relief.” (quoting *Golden v. State*, 870 So. 2d 167, 167 (Fla. 2d DCA 2004)); accord *Meader v. State*, No. 4D09-4952 (Fla. 4th DCA Apr. 27, 2011).

Affirmed.
