PER CURIAM.

After a default had been entered against the borrower in a mortgage foreclosure action, the circuit court *sua sponte* dismissed the case for the plaintiff's lack of standing to file the complaint. We reverse on the authority of *National City Bank v. Nagel*, 95 So. 3d 458 (Fla. 4th DCA 2012) and remand to the circuit court for further proceedings. *See also GMAC Mort.*, *LLC. v. Choengkroy*, No. 4D11-3531 (Fla. 4th DCA Oct. 17, 2012).
