



Florida Rule of Criminal Procedure 3.800(b), arguing that Young's sentences in those two cases should be designated as youthful offender sentences because he was originally sentenced as a youthful offender in those cases. See Yegge v. State, 88 So. 3d 1058, 1059-60 (Fla. 2d DCA 2012). In a timely order, the trial court granted the motion, ordering that Young "is sentenced to 205.8 months in the Department of Corrections as a Youthful Offender." However, the order lists only case number 00-21009 and not case number 01-2491. Accordingly, we remand for the trial court to grant Young's motion in case number 01-2491 and to enter amended sentences in both case numbers 00-21009 and 01-2491 reflecting Young's youthful offender status.

Affirmed; remanded.
