Edward Closuit, Myriam Murphy, and Andalite Industries, Inc., appeal an order finding them in contempt for violating an injunction and assessing attorney's fees

and costs as a sanction. As we did in the related case of <u>Osmo Tec SAVC Co. v. Crane Environmental, Inc.</u>, No. 2D03-498 (Fla. 2d DCA Sept. 8, 2004), we reverse because the injunction did not prohibit the sale of Andalite's assets to a third party.

Reversed and remanded.
