PER CURIAM.

Eugene Blocker appeals from a final order of the Unemployment Appeals
Commission affirming the appeals referee's decision which found Blocker disqualified

from receiving unemployment compensation benefits and requiring Blocker to repay \$289 in benefits. Our review of the record in this appeal supports the appeals referee's finding that Blocker voluntarily left employment without good cause attributable to the employer.
