We have for review <u>Fawdry v. State</u>, 70 So. 3d 626, 627 (Fla. 1st DCA 2011), in which the First District Court of Appeal affirmed a trial court order that denied a motion to suppress evidence found on a cellular phone without a search warrant. The First District certified the following question as one of great public importance:

DOES THE HOLDING IN <u>U.S. v. ROBINSON</u>, 414 U.S. 218 (1973) ALLOW A POLICE OFFICER TO SEARCH THROUGH PHOTOGRAPHS CONTAINED WITHIN A CELL PHONE WHICH IS ON AN ARRESTEE'S PERSON AT THE TIME OF A VALID ARREST?

Id. at 630-31. We have jurisdiction. Art. V, § 3(b)(4), Fla. Const.

We stayed proceedings in this case pending the disposition of <u>Smallwood v.</u>

<u>State</u>, 113 So. 3d 724 (Fla. 2013). When <u>Smallwood</u> became final, we issued an order directing Respondent to show cause why this Court should not accept jurisdiction, summarily quash the decision in <u>Fawdry</u>, and remand for reconsideration in light of the decision in <u>Smallwood</u>. Respondent filed a response, but Petitioner did not reply.

Upon consideration of the response, we grant the petition for review, quash the decision in <u>Fawdry</u>, and remand this case to the First District Court of Appeal for further proceedings consistent with the decision in <u>Smallwood</u>.

It is so ordered.
