PER CURIAM.

We have for review <u>Steadman v. State</u>, 997 So. 2d 417 (Fla. 2d DCA 2008) (table), in which the Second District Court of Appeal cited as authority its decision in <u>Gisi v. State</u>, 948 So. 2d 816 (Fla. 2d DCA 2007), <u>quashed</u>, 4 So. 3d 613 (Fla. 2009). At the time the Second District issued its <u>Steadman</u> decision, <u>Gisi</u> was pending review in this Court. We have jurisdiction. <u>See</u> art. V, § 3(b)(3), Fla. Const.; <u>Jollie v. State</u>, 405 So. 2d 418 (Fla. 1981).

We stayed proceedings in this case pending our disposition of <u>State v. Rabedeau</u>, 2 So. 3d 191 (Fla. 2009) (disapproving the Second District's <u>Gisi decision</u>), and <u>Gisi v. State</u>, 4 So. 3d 613 (Fla. 2009) (quashing the Second

District's <u>Gisi</u> decision). We then issued an order directing respondent in the present case to show cause why we should not accept jurisdiction, quash the Second District's underlying <u>Steadman</u> decision and remand for reconsideration in light of our decisions in <u>Rabedeau</u> and <u>Gisi</u>. Upon considering respondent's response, and petitioner's reply thereto, we have determined to so proceed.

We accordingly accept jurisdiction and grant the petition for review in the present case. The decision under review is quashed, and this matter is remanded to the Second District for reconsideration upon application of this Court's decisions in Rabedeau and Gisi.

It is so ordered.
