We reverse and remand consistent with our recent decision in <u>United Automobile Insurance Co. v. Millennium Radiology, LLC</u>, 47 Fla. L. Weekly D175, — So.3d —, 2022 WL 107604 (Fla. 3d DCA Jan. 12, 2022) ("Millennium's 'identity' is not the same in each of these cases against United Auto; Millennium draws its identity from its assignor from case to case. The identity element of collateral estoppel, therefore, is not satisfied.").
