SUMMARY DISPOSITION ORDER

Solomon David Dennis appeals, *pro se*, the July 13, 2004 judgment of the District Court of the First Circuit (district court)¹ that convicted him of standing or parking his taxi on a public highway while waiting for a fare to hire his taxi, in violation of Revised Ordinances of Honolulu § 12-4.4(b) (1990).
