## ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

(By: Moon, C.J., Levinson, Nakayama, Ramil, and Acoba, JJ.)

Upon review of the record, it appears that the July 22, 2002 notice of appeal was prepared, signed and filed by Dr. David Ben-Chayil KCR on behalf of appellant Oliver Vladimir Kozlik.

Ben-Chayil is not an attorney licensed to practice law in Hawai'i and he cannot represent Kozlik before the supreme court. See

Hawai'i Revised Statutes §§ 605-2 and 605-14; Oahu Plumbing and Sheet Metal, Ltd. v. Kona Construction, Inc., 60 Haw. 372, 376-377, 590 P.2d 570, 574 (1979) ("natural persons . . . are permitted . . . to appear pro se[;] nevertheless, . . . such natural persons are not permitted to act as 'attorneys' and

represent other natural persons in *their* causes."). Thus, the July 22, 2002 notice of appeal is invalid. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this appeal is dismissed.
