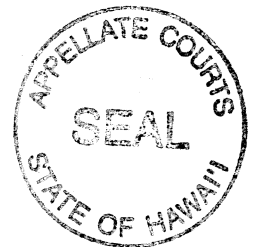
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the motion for extension of time to file an application for a writ of certiorari is denied.
