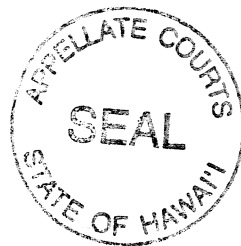
The memorandum opinion in the above-entitled appeal
