

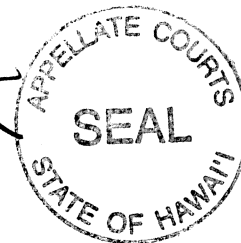
shall not exceed 5 pages in length and shall be filed by July 16, 2009.
