DOWNING, J.

This lawsuit arises from a motor vehicle accident. Following a trial on the merits, plaintiffs appealed the judgment dismissing their suit. The only issue on appeal is whether the jury erred in determining that the driver of the vehicle that caused the accident was not an "employee" of the construction company for whom he occasionally worked.

After a thorough review, we conclude that the record does not demonstrate that the decision of the jury was manifestly erroneous. Thus, in accordance with Uniform Rules - Courts of Appeal Rule 2-16.2(4) and (6), we affirm the judgment rendered in the trial court. All costs of this appeal are assessed against the plaintiffs-appellants, Michael and Cynthia Arnold.
