WRIT GRANTED IN PART AND DENIED IN PART. Article 701(F) of the Code of Criminal Procedure requires the trial court to schedule a pro se motion for speedy trial (that is not verified by counsel's affidavit) for a contradictory hearing. See **State v. Miller**, 97-00761 (La. App. 3d Cir. 7/10/97), 699 So.2d 448. Accordingly, if it has not already done so, the trial court is ordered to proceed to disposition on relator's request for speedy trial. In all other respects, the writ is denied.
