
**WRIT AND MOTION FOR STAY OF EZZARD BOWMAN'S AUTHORITY
AS ADMINISTRATOR OF JOSEPH DANGERFIELD'S SUCCESSION
GRANTED.** The trial court abused its discretion in denying
Mrs. Dangerfield's exception raising the objection of no
right of action and the ruling is vacated to allow for
additional evidence to be presented at a hearing. This
matter is remanded to the lower court to determine if
Ezzard Bowman has established paternity for succession
purposes under the provisions of La. C.C. art. 197 and/or
whether the last will and testament of Mr. Dangerfield is
valid and legally enforceable, and if so, whether Issac
Bowman and Ezzard Bowman are one and the same person.
