

After conducting a *de novo* review of the factual evidence presented, I conclude there is no genuine issue of material fact and relator, City of Baton Rouge/Parish of East Baton Rouge, is entitled to judgment as a matter of law. Accordingly, I would grant the writ application and reverse the judgment of the trial court rendered on May 20, 2013, which denied the motion for summary judgment, and render judgment dismissing the plaintiff's claims against relator with prejudice.
