

**McDONALD, J.**, dissents and would grant the writ. In the absence of a showing of good cause for plaintiffs' failure to timely request service on defendants, Charles G. Hall and ABC Insurance Company, the district court erred in denying relator's properly filed motion to dismiss under La. C.C.P. art. 1672(C). I would reverse the judgment of the district court and grant the motion to dismiss plaintiffs' suit against Hall and ABC Insurance Company, dismissing the suit without prejudice as to them.
