

WRIT GRANTED. The Louisiana Civil Service Commission has exclusive subject matter jurisdiction over this dispute. Accordingly, we conclude that the district court erred in overruling the declinatory exception of lack of subject matter jurisdiction filed by the State of Louisiana through the Department of Children and Family Services. We reverse the judgment of the district court, maintain the exception of lack of subject matter jurisdiction, and dismiss the subject petition filed by Carolyn Morrison and Carolyn Hall.
