Supplementation of this writ application and/or an application for rehearing will not be considered. Uniform Rules of Louisiana Court of Appeal, Rules 4-9 and 2-18.7.

In the event that the plaintiff seeks to file a new application with this Court, it must contain all pertinent documentation and must comply with the Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, Rules 4.1 and 4.5. Any new application must be filed on or before March 17, 2014, and must contain a copy of this ruling.
