
WRIT DENIED IN PART AND DENIED ON THE SHOWING MADE IN PART. Relator failed to include a copy of his application for postconviction relief filed with the trial court, the minute entries, all pertinent transcripts, the bill of information, the state's answer to his application for postconviction relief, and any other portions of the district court record that might support the claims raised in the application for postconviction relief. Thus, relator's claims of ineffective assistance of counsel and his plea agreement are denied on the showing made.

Supplementation of this writ application and/or an application for rehearing will not be considered. See Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal; Rules 2-18.7 & 4-9. Any future filing on these two claims should include the entire contents of this application, the missing items noted above, and a copy of this ruling. In the event relator elects to file a new application with this Court, the application must be filed on or before July 29, 2013.

Relator's claim of excessive sentence and his request for patent error review are denied. See La. Code Crim. P. arts. 920(2) & 930.3.
