

WRIT DENIED. Relator appears to seek review of the denial of his pro se motion for speedy trial and/or to force his appointed attorney to file the same motion. When a defendant is represented by counsel and it is not clear whether or not counsel joins in the pre-verdict pro se motion filed by the defendant, the trial court is required to accept and consider the motion provided the motion will not lead to confusion at trial. See **State v. Melon**, 95-2209 (La. 9/22/95), 660 So.2d 466. Herein, the documentation provided in relator's application supports a finding that relator's counsel did not join in the filing of the pro se motion for speedy trial.
