Relator represents that the district court has failed to comply with this Court's action in 2013 KW 0255, wherein this Court found merit in relator's claim that the district court erred in ruling that the application for postconviction relief, filed in October 2012 was untimely, and vacated the ruling dismissing the application for postconviction relief, and remanded this matter for the district court (Division C) to reconsider the application for postconviction relief. We are advised by the office of the Clerk of Court of St. Mary Parish that relator's case has been reallotted to Division A. If relator's representation is correct, Division A is ordered to consider the merits of the application for postconviction relief, if it has not already done so.

Relative to the application for postconviction relief filed in May 2013, the writ is denied on the showing made. Relator failed to include the application for postconviction relief, the transcript of the guilty plea, and any other portions of the district court record that might support the claims raised in the application for postconviction relief. Supplementation of this writ application and/or an application for rehearing will not be considered. See Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, Rules 2-18.7 & 4-9. Any future filing on this issue should include the entire contents of this application, the missing items noted above, and a copy of this ruling. In the event relator elects to file a new application with this Court, the application shall be filed on or before January 14, 2014.
