WRIT DENIED as premature. Because the trial court has yet to rule on relator's claim of ineffective assistance of counsel in this matter, it would be premature for this Court to consider the other seven claims raised in relator's application for postconviction relief. Upon obtaining a ruling by the trial court on his remaining claim, relator may seek review as to any adverse ruling on that claim and the other remaining claims after that determination. We note that any writ application which seeks review of the trial court's ruling on relator's application for postconviction relief should include the application for postconviction relief, the state's answer, if any, the trial court's ruling, and any other portions of the district court record that might support the claims raised in the application for postconviction relief.
