A certified copy of the trust fund account statement (STATEMENT OF ACCOUNT Certified Institutional Equivalent) or institutional equivalent for the six-month period immediately preceding the filing of the writ application obtained from the appropriate prison official at the institution in which you are confined, for compliance with La. R.S. 15:1186.

We also note that your application does not contain any of the affidavits and documents required by Rule 4-5, Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal.

We are returning your writ application. If relator intends to pursue this claim, you must (1) include the required documents as to your inability to pay; and (2) provide a copy of the documents filed at the lower court with any writ application submitted on your behalf. This Court is unable to process the application until the required documentation is submitted.

In the event you elect to file a new application, please include all of the documents that are being returned to you.
