Supplementation of this writ application and/or an application for rehearing will not be considered. See Uniform Rule of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, Rules 2-18.7 & 4-9. In the event relator elects to file a new application with this Court, the application must be filed on or before May 6, 2014. Any future filing on this issue should include the entire contents of this application, the missing items noted above, and a copy of this ruling.
