WRIT GRANTED. Relator's conviction for criminal mischief is reversed, the sentence is vacated, and relator is ordered discharged. The fact that relator lied to Sgt. Garig about the dog's whereabouts during the course of his investigation did not constitute intentionally giving a false report or complaint to Sgt. Garig relative to the commission of a theft or receipt of stolen goods. See State v. Robertson, 364 So.2d 915 (La. 1978). Thus, viewing the evidence in the light most favorable to the prosecution, the State did not prove beyond a reasonable doubt that relator committed criminal mischief.
