

WRIT GRANTED WITH ORDER. Because the district court found Walker & Sons, Inc. in contempt of court and imposed sanctions against it pursuant to La. Code Civ. P. art. 1471(A), the district court's February 18, 2014 judgment is a final, appealable judgment. La. Code Civ. P. art. 1915. **Robinson v. Harlan**, 2012-0363 (La. 4/9/12), 85 So.3d 131. The writ is granted for the limited purpose of remanding this matter to the district court with instructions to grant relator an appeal pursuant to his notice of intent to seek writs, which was filed on March 18, 2014. See In Re Howard, 541 So.2d 195, 197 (La. 1989). Additionally, a copy of this Court's order is to be included in the appellate record.
