Relator has failed to comply with Rules 4-2, 4-3 and 4-5(11), Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, in that the application does not contain a copy of the notice of intent showing the filing date and a signed copy of the return date order setting the date fixed by the trial court for filing the application with this Court.

Relator has failed to comply with Rules 4-5(A)(B) and (C)(1), (2), (3), (4)(5) and (6), Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, in that it is not clear from the documentation provided which ruling is being challenged. This Court generally does not consider applications that do not contain documentation of the trial court's ruling.


Additionally, relator has failed to comply with Rule 4-5(8), Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal. In order for this Court to examine the trial court's ruling, it must be presented with the pleadings reviewed by the trial court.

Supplementation of this writ application and/or an application for rehearing will not be considered. Rules 4-9 and 2-18.7, Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal.

In the event relator seeks to file a new application with this Court, it must contain all pertinent documentation, and must comply with Rules 2-12.2, Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal. See Rule 4-5(A), as well as 4-5(C). Any new application must be filed on or before June 30, 2014, and must contain a copy of this ruling.
