

La. C.C.P. art. 1914 and Rule 4-3 of the Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal. Further, Relator did not include a copy of the petition in violation of Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal Rule 4-5(C)(8), such that the writ application fails to comply with Rule 4-5 of the Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal.

Supplementation of this writ application and/or an application for rehearing will not be considered. Rules 4-9 and 2-18.7, Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal.

In the event relators seek to file a new application with this Court, it must contain all pertinent documentation and must comply with Rule 2-12.2 of the Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal. Any new application must be filed on or before (14 days from action date) and must contain a copy of this ruling.
