writ not considered. Relator was convicted and sentenced on February 25, 2013. Relator's pleading seeking misdemeanor review of the conviction and sentence was not filed until January 21, 2014. Accordingly, relator failed to comply with Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, Rules 4-3 and 4-5(C)(11), by failing to timely request a return date. Although the affidavit is initialed, there is no other information that identifies the notary. If the notary is an attorney licensed to practice in Louisiana, he may use his Louisiana state bar roll number in lieu of his notary identification number. La. R.S. 35:12(B). Furthermore, the witnesses also initialed the affidavit instead of printing their names. Notaries shall print or type the full names of the parties under their respective signatures. See La. R.S. 35:12(A)(1). Relator failed to comply with Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, Rule 4-5(A), by failing to include in the affidavit the telephone numbers of opposing counsel and the judge. Relator also failed to comply with the page numbering requirements of Rule 4-5(B).
