WRIT DENIED. Because relator did not file an appeal, the convictions and sentences in the cases at issue in this writ became final thirty days after June 6, 2008. Therefore, the application for postconviction relief, filed in 2014, is untimely for purposes of postconviction relief and the claim of an exception to the time limit is without merit. See La. Code Crim. P. art. 930.8(A). Furthermore, see the action of this Court in 2013 KW 1518, wherein this Court denied relator's writ seeking review of a similar claim.
